## Sub:Procurement through State e-Procurement PortalRef:IT Department Notification No.IT.69/2011/363, dtd.15.10.2014

- 1. The Department of Commerce, Government of India is implementing and monitoring e-Procurement Mission Mode Project (MMP) in all states and Union Territories as part of the National Mission on e-Governance.
- Accordingly, IT Department, Government of Assam vide Notification no. IT.69/2011/363, dtd.15.10.2014 has notified nine departments/agencies to adopt the e-procurement route for procurement of goods, works and services above Rs.1.00 Crore. These departments/agencies are:

i. PHE, ii. Irrigation, iii. GDD (GMDA & GMC), iv. Water Resource, y. IT (AMTRON), vi. Secondary Education (RMSA), vii. Power Department (APGCL), viii. Health Department (NRHM) and ix. PWD (Roads).

- 3. NIC-Assam has already developed the State e-Procurement Portal (<u>www.assamtenders.gov.in</u>) and set up a Facility Management Unit (FMU) at 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, C-Block of the Assam Secretariat. This Portal is open for use by any Department/Board/PSU etc. for procurement of any amount. IT Department will provide necessary hand holding support and issue of Digital Signature Certificate etc.
- 4. Government of India is considering to make the e-Tendering compulsory from the next Financial Year (2015-16) for any scheme using Central assistance in any form.
- Consequent to the above, all concerned Department (s) and their constituent Board/PSUs etc. are advised to adopt the e-procurement route for any procurement of goods, works or services or any combination thereof above Rs.1.00 Crore from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2015.
- 6. This OM will come into force with immediate effect.
